SUBJECT: FY2012 Solid Waste Annual Reporting (SWARWeb) Schedule

1. References:
 - a. Executive Order (E.O.) 13514, Federal Leadership in Environmental, Energy, and Economic Performance, 5 Oct 09.
 - b. FY2011 DoD Strategic Sustainability Performance Plan (SSPP), Jun 2011
 - c. Army Regulation 420-1, Army Facilities Management, 12 Feb 08.
2. The mid-year SWARWeb data call for the first two Quarters of FY2012 is required by 15 Jun 2012. The mid-year data call provides an opportunity to validate monthly reporting, User ID's, and Passwords; ensure that data entry questions and issues are resolved; and enables installations and their headquarters to determine progress towards the mandated waste diversion, Construction and Demolition (C&D) debris diversion, and composting goals.
3. In addition, the SWARWeb year-end report for FY2012 is required by 15 Nov 2012. For Congressional reporting, it is important that SWARWeb data is entered monthly for the entire fiscal year and submitted through command channels in time to synchronize with the annual Defense Environmental Program Annual Report to Congress (DEPARC) and DoD SSPP reporting.
4. In FY2012, installations are required to report the amount of compostable and organic materials diverted from the waste stream relative to the 2010 baseline to either on-site or off-site composting facilities. SWARWEB will calculate the percent change and report whether the change is positive, negative, or zero even though there is no numeric metric goal.
5. Although the Army's solid waste diversion rate for FY2011 missed the mandated 42% goal provided on the enclosed table, the generation of solid waste was maintained at 3 lbs per person per day. Installations will need to make significant improvement to meet the DoD SSPP MSW diversion target of 44% for FY2012. This requires 42% plus 2% annual increase to divert a total of 50% by FY2015 to meet mandates.
