SUBJECT: Funding Responsibilities for Army Lead-Based Paint and Asbestos Programs

1. References

2. The purpose of this memorandum is to establish guidance that clarifies funding responsibilities for Army Lead-Based Paint and Asbestos Activities.

3. Base Support funding guidance is as follows:

a. Base Operations Support - Environmental Compliance Funding (xxxx56.xx Account) will be used for:

- NESHAP fees as required by the Clean Air Act
- Employee training as required by 40 CFR 745 and 40 CFR 763
- Waste disposal when separate from renovation and demolition and if considered a RCRA hazardous waste by the state

b. Base Operations Support - Municipal Services (xxxx79.xx Account) funds will be used for:

- Surveys and assessments to identify lead and asbestos hazards
- Development and maintenance of hazard management plans

c. Army Family Housing Operations (AFHO) ("1900" Account) funds will be used for:

- Surveys and assessments to identify lead and asbestos hazards
- Development and maintenance of hazard management plans
- Control of lead and asbestos through in-place management or abatement

d. Sustainment, Restoration and Modernization (xxxx78.xx Account) will be used for:

- Control of lead and asbestos through in-place management or abatement for Army facilities other than Army Family Housing
