
MEMORANDUM FOR Assistant Secretary of the Army (Installations, Energy and Environment)

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority to Approve Intergovernmental Support Agreements Entered Into Pursuant to Title 10 United States Code Section 2336

1. I hereby delegate to the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Installations, Energy and Environment), the authority to approve the Army entering into intergovernmental support agreements (IGSA) with State and local governments for the purpose of providing, receiving or sharing installation support services. Use of this authority is subject to your determination that an IGSA will serve the best interests of the Army by enhancing mission effectiveness or creating efficiencies or economies of scale, including reduced cost(s) that benefit the Army.
2. If use of this authority results in the Army's acquisition of supplies or services, the IGSA will be implemented through use of a contract that complies with all applicable requirements of the Federal Acquisition Regulations to the extent required by applicable law.
3. Consistent with the provisions at Title 10 United States Code section 2336(a)(2), at your discretion IGSA may:
 - a. be entered into on a sole-source basis,
 - b. be for a term not to exceed 5 years, and
 - c. require the use of wage grades normally paid by the State or local government for the installation-support services being acquired.
4. Although not a limitation on your authority to act on my behalf, in those cases where your proposed decision represents a change in precedent or policy; is of significant White House, congressional, Department or public interest; or has been, or should be, of interest or concern to me, you will brief me before making the decision unless the exigencies of the situation prevent the briefing.

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority to Approve Intergovernmental Support Agreements Entered Into Pursuant to Title 10 United States Code Section 2336

5. This delegation is effective immediately and expires 3 years from the date of this memorandum, unless earlier suspended, revoked or superseded. All prior delegations of this authority are hereby revoked.
