SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority to Approve Intergovernmental Support Agreements  
Entered into Pursuant to 10 U.S.C. § 2679

1. You are hereby delegated the authority to enter into Intergovernmental Support Agreements (IGSA) with State and local governments to provide, receive, or share installation-supported services pursuant to 10 U.S.C. Section 2679 with an annual value not to exceed \$1,000,000. You may authorize the use of an IGSA upon your determination that an IGSA will serve the best interests of the Army by enhancing mission effectiveness or creating efficiencies or economies of scale, including the reduction of cost(s), in a manner that benefits the Army.
2. You may re-delegate your authority to authorize entering into an IGSA to a General Officer or member of the Senior Executive Service with an annual individual value of \$500,000 or less. Should you choose to do so, you may restrict or condition that delegation. Notwithstanding any further delegation, I will hold you responsible for all actions taken pursuant to this delegation of authority.
3. Although not a limitation on your authority to act on my behalf, in those cases where a proposed decision to enter into an IGSA represents a change in precedent or policy; is of significant White House, Congressional, Department or public interest; or has been, or should be, of interest or concern to me, you will brief me prior to any decision to exercise the authority I have delegated unless exigencies preclude such action.
4. HQDA Execution Order 200-16 details the requirements for entering into and recording IGSA's.
